David Reuben Anderson, 85, passed on May 14, 2020, at his winter home in Glendale, AZ.

The son of Reuben Howard Anderson and Agnes Genevieve (Erickson) Anderson, David was an Eagle Scout, AHMED Shriner and member of the Masonic Lodge of Iron Mountain and Norway. He retired from the Crivitz School system where he taught history and psychology. He was the president of the Spring Valley Ranch Corporation and founder of the Anderson Memorial Foundation, dedicated to helping second year college students majoring in nursing or medicine. In 1963 he married Carol Miska, who passed in 1999.

David is survived by his spouse, Duane Peck; a sister, Jean Hardy; his nephews and cousins; his dear friend, Lawrence Lundin; and many business and personal friends in Michigan and Arizona.
