IRON MOUNTAIN - David J. Bilski, 68, of 836 East I St. in Iron Mountain, died unexpectedly on Monday, June 29, 2009.

He was born June 14, 1941, in Norway, son of the late Jacob and Agnes (Stanek) Bilski. He graduated from the Vulcan High School in 1959.

He married his high school sweetheart, Janise Vivio, on Aug. 17, 1963, at St. Mary Catholic Church in Norway.

Dave began his work career as a surveyor for Kimberly-Clark. He worked for the Hanna Mining Co. for 17 years as a heavy equipment operator and finished his career in the maintenance department at the Iron Mountain High School before retiring.
