David Warren "Dave" Weber, 55, of 519 Houghteling St. in Iron Mountain died at Froedtert Hospital in Milwaukee on Thursday, November 4, 2010, after a courageous battle with colon cancer.

He was born September 9, 1955 in Iron Mountain, the son of the late Warren and Marian (Rolando) Weber. Dave was a lifelong resident of Iron Mountain. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1973 and Northern Michigan University in 1977.

Dave was the longtime owner of Sound North on Stephenson Avenue, and was active in the consumer electronics business in the U.P. and Northern Wisconsin for over thirty years. He was also involved with numerous trade groups and associations both locally and nationally.

Dave was a member of Pine Grove Country Club and loved to golf. He was also active in the Pine Mountain Ski Patrol for many years, combining his passion for skiing with his desire to help others. In this capacity he achieved numerous certifications in emergency medical training.

Dave often spent time with family and friends at Sundog Lake in Republic, enjoying relaxation, water sports, good food and good cheer.

He was a member of American Martyrs Catholic Church.

He is survived by his sister, Sheri Schmit (Joe) of Pewaukee, WI, niece Nicole and nephew Ryan. He is also survived by his uncle, Don Rolando (Mary Jane) of Neenah, WI, his uncle, Paul Weber (Lavonne) and aunt, Marcia Weber, both of Minnesota, along with numerous other relatives and friends.

Visitation will be held on Sunday from 4:00 to 7:00pm at Erickson-Rochon and Nash Funeral Home in Iron Mountain. Funeral services will be on Monday at 10:00am at American Martyrs Catholic Church in Kingsford. Fr. Joseph Gouin will offer the Mass of Christian Burial. Burial will take place in Cemetery Park.
