David A. Furno, 37, of Iron Mountain, passed away unexpectedly at home on October 19, 2022, after a long battle with mental illness.

David was born in Iron Mountain, MI, on September 9, 1985, to Debra and Michael Furno.

David graduated from Iron Mountain High School on May 28, 2004. After graduation he attended college for a year and went on to work for M. J. Electric for over 14 years. He enjoyed working for M. J. Electric because it is known as a very family-oriented company. He worked in the vehicle department and was lovingly known as "Turbo." David enjoyed being with his friends and said he'd be up for anything – mountain biking, fishing, camping, kayaking and road trips. David enjoyed going to camp with his dad and brothers, hunting and off-roading with his side by side. He also loved going snowboarding with his brother. He thoroughly enjoyed shooting his bow as he had a good eye for it. David's favorite pastime was on-line gaming as he was good at it according to opponents. David will be greatly missed by his family and friends.
