David C. Lindblom, 84, of Kingsford passed away Saturday, August 5, 2023, at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center in Iron Mountain.

David was born August 2, 1939, in Iron Mountain, son of the late Carl and Florence (Arbour) Lindblom. He graduated from Kingsford High School in 1957 and with his best friend, Ted, went into the US Air Force. He spent 4 years at the ENT Air Force Base in Colorado, then 18 months in Libya, Africa, and then Wurtsmith Air Force Base in lower Michigan before going to work the ore docks in Escanaba. In 1966 he moved to Norway and went to work for the Milwaukee Road, moving to Kingsford and worked at Grede Foundry, retiring after 34 years. He wasn't done yet; he made sure their coaches were inspected and safe. If he found anything wrong, he sent them to Rochon's Bus Service and later Inland Diesel for service. They owned and operated Judi's Getaway Tours. He enjoyed going to the casino and going to his children's sporting events: wrestling, basketball, baseball, football, soccer, and music events. He was also quite into model railroading.
