David J. Roy, 90, of Foster City, went to be with the Lord on Thursday, September 4, 2014 at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center.

David was born August 21, 1924 in Chicago, IL son of the late John and Barbara (Grimes) Roy. He moved to Carlshend, MI in 1935 and served in the Civilian Conservation Camps before joining the United States Army. David served during WWII with Army Company A, 11th Infantry under General Pattons 3rd Army, 5th Division. He was involved in many conflicts from Normandy to the Battle of the Bulge and received the Purple Heart. Altogether he served nine years, five months and fifteen days before his honorable discharge as Sergeant in 1955. He went on to work for the Commissary at K.I. Sawyer in Gwinn for 14 years. David married Audrey (Fayas) Peterson on September 9, 2002 in Georgia.

He enjoyed camping, hunting, fishing, traveling and his church. David got great enjoyment watching the wildlife in his yard.

He is survived by his wife, Audrey; four daughters, Alice Stoker of Georgia, Brenda (Al) Behms of Georgia, Mary (Jodi) Luhm of Gwinn and Lori (Barry) Jones of California; a son, David (Rieko)Johns of Japan; sister, Margaret Gauthier of Little Lake, MI; step daughter, Phyllis Rowe of Illinois; 22 grandchildren, 40 great grandchildren and 8-great great grandhchildren; many
