KINGSFORD - Dean N. Julian, 74, of Kingsford, died on Tuesday, March 31, 2009, at the Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain, after a courageous battle with cancer.

He was born on Sept. 3, 1934, on the westside of Iron Mountain, son of the late Russell and Irene (Champagne) Julian.

He attended the Kingsford schools, graduating from Kingsford High School in 1952. After graduating high school, he joined the United States Army and was honorably discharged.

He married Rita O'Connor on Nov. 26, 1955, and they would share more than 54 years together. He worked in construction for many years and was a long time member of the Construction and General Laborers Union Local 1329. He retired on Aug. 1, 1987, due to health reasons.

Dean was a member of the First Covenant Church in Iron Mountain. He loved to play golf, hunt and fish. He was an avid Packer fan and watched college basketball, professional baseball and golf on TV. He also attended many Flivver games over the years.

Dean is survived by his loving wife, Rita of Kingsford; children, Janee'

(Lawrence) Mosca of Bush Lake, Doreen (Paul) Bellmore of Quinnesec, Allan Julian of Iron Mountain, and Brian Julian of Norway, nine grandchildren and three great-grandchildren and a brother, Richard (Sharon) Julian of Marinette, Wis.

Dean was preceded in death by a son, Kevin, two brothers Russell and Wayne and a sister, Alice (Manci).

Visitation will be held on Saturday, from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. at the First Covenant Church in Iron Mountain.

The funeral service will follow at 11 a.m. at the church. Rev. Peter Erickson will officiate.

Burial will be in Cemetery Park in Iron Mountain at a later date.
