Debra Ann McDaniel Allen Querio, 56, of Otter Creek, Florida, passed away Sunday, Feb. 19, 2017. She was born in North Kansas City, MO on June 10, 1960. The family lived several years in Missouri and Kansas before returning to Iron Mountain in 1968. Debra graduated from Kingsford High School, married and moved to Little Suamico, WI, where she raised her two children. While living in WI, she worked at the Hyway Restaurant fifteen years and received her Realtors license. She also had a small restaurant and ice cream shop with her husband Tim for a few years in Krakow, WI, before making the final move to Florida.
