Delores "Dee" R. Laydon, 94, of Kingsford passed away Monday, January 10, 2022, at Evergreen Assisted Living in Kingsford.

Dee was born July 22, 1927, in Iron Mountain, the daughter of Jacob and Mary (Zitkovitz) Rubbo. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1945 and married Gordon Laydon on September 24, 1946, at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Iron Mountain. Dee worked as an accountant for Santoni Lumber and Fuel and later for Dickinson Homes.

Dee was a member of Queen of Peace Catholic Church and a former member of the Pine Grove Country Club, Chippewa Club, and the American Business Women of America (ABWA). In her younger years she was active in the local Tuesday night women's bowling leagues. She also had a passion for playing cards and was a member of two long running card clubs. Dee loved her family and friends, and her house was the hub of holiday gatherings, parties, and many an after-work cocktail hour. Dee was a special person, as witnessed by many, and she will be greatly missed.
