



## Deloris Carlson

January 26, 1927 - August 7, 2011

On Saturday, August 7, 2011, God took our beloved Deloris Carlson of Foster City to live with Him in Heaven, while she peacefully slept. Deloris was born on January 26, 1927 in Escanaba, MI, daughter of the late Earl and Clara (Swanson) Varney. Deloris married her childhood sweetheart and best friend, Wallace Carlson, on February 26, 1949 in an evening candlelit ceremony at the Mission Covenant Church in Foster City. Deloris was a lifelong resident of the Foster City area, where she was known for singing with her sister Marie (Varney) Larson. In the 1940's they could be heard on the local radio stations of the Iron Mountain area as well as stations in Chicago. Deloris also made singing presentations at the Norway Fair, at business meetings and was frequently seen playing her guitar and singing at many church functions. Her love for music also led her to play the accordion & tambourine and even some yodeling. In 1974, Deloris received her LPN degree, for she always took care of those she loved so dearly. Deloris was an active member of the Mission Covenant Church where she was part of the ladies aid group for many years, helping to serve the community. Things that brought her joy in life were spending time with family and friends, traveling, camping, cooking, baking, planting flowers and gardening.

Deloris is survived by two sons, Don (Sue) Carlson and Robert "Bob" Carlson, both of Foster City; a brother, Dale (Betty) Varney of Escanaba; son-in-law, Jerry Steele of Escanaba; grandchildren, Jim (Michelle) Steele of Traverse
