



## Dennis E. Dorn

October 18, 1946 - May 23, 2020

Dennis E. Dorn, 73, of Aurora, passed away at home on May 23, 2020.

Dennis was born on October 18, 1946, in Appleton, WI, son of the late Edwin and Loretta (Coenen) Dorn. He was raised in the Appleton area and was a graduate of Appleton West High School. He went on to attend Fox Valley Technical College. Dennis joined the United States Army in 1966. He served in the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged as a Sergeant in 1969. Dennis worked for the Niagara of Wisconsin Paper Mill for many years, retiring in 2003. He married Margaret Rae Howen on January 17, 1981, at the Assembly of God Church in Seymour, WI.

Dennis was a member of Maranatha Assembly of God Church in Kingsford. He was a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion and the Northwoods Tractor Club. His greatest joy was his grandchildren and great grandchildren. Dennis also enjoyed gospel and country music, horses, John Deere tractors, old cars and travelling the United States, especially Tennessee. He loved watching a good sunset while praising the Lord for a beautiful day.
