Dolores Bardon, 67, of Norway, died Thurs. June 9, 2011, at ManorCare West in Green Bay with complications of end stage kidney failure . She was born on Nov. 27, 1943 in Bessemer, MI, the daughter of the late Gunnard and Elsie (Nylund) Lindstrom.
