Donald A. Legault, 80, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Monday, October 3, 2016 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

He was born October 10, 1935 in Kingsford, son of the late Andrew and Helen (Kassin) Legault. Don graduated from Kingsford High School in 1953 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Following graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served his country during the Korean War. Don married Donna Freeman on February 19, 1966 in Iron Mountain. He was a firefighter for the City of Iron Mountain for 25 years, retiring in 1991. He also worked for Tony Izzo and Sons as a carpet layer for over 15 years.
