Donald Jay Mott, 71, of Aurora went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, Oct. 20, 2024, at Marshfield Medical Center - Dickinson.

He was born in Keshena, WI on August 19, 1953, son of the late Donald James and Helen (Eastvold) Mott. Donnie was a graduate of Iron Mountain High School class of '72.
