IRON MOUNTAIN - Donald Rouse, 79, of 1108 Prospect Ave., Iron Mountain, formerly of 1710 S. Stephenson Ave., Iron Mountain, died Sunday, Dec. 29, 2002, at his home.

He was born Sept. 20, 1923, in Aurora, Wis., son of the late Edward and Cora (Schabel) Rouse. Donald married Marion Lindgren on June 12, 1943. She preceded him in death on Jan. 21, 1994. He had been a resident of the area for most of his life. Donald worked as a bricklayer for the Local Union 6.
