Dora Sadie Cohodes, 91, of Iron Mountain, died Sunday, April 25, 2010, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

She was born Sept. 8, 1918, in Akron, Ohio, daughter of the late Phillip and Lena (Milakoff) Dwoskin. Dora was a long time resident of Iron Mountain.

She married Philip Cohodes on June 14, 1942. Dora was the office manager for M. Cohodes Sons for 27 years before retiring. She was a member of the Anshe-Knesseth Israel Synagogue. Dora was also a former member of the Iron Mountain-Kingsford Lions Club, Zonta, Iron Mountain Women's Club, the Lady Elks, and the Order of the Eastern Star.
