Douglas E. Oliver, 65, of Quinnesec, passed away on Monday, February 18, 2019 at his home.

Doug was born on December 20, 1953 in Iron Mountain, the son of Dale and Barbara (Nelson) Oliver. 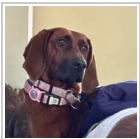
