Duaine F. Schaut,

74 of Aurora, passed away on Monday, Sept. 12, 2011 at his home. He was born on July 10, 1937 in LaBranche, Michigan, son of the late Clifford P. and Louise M. (Gunville) Schaut. Duaine was raised in this area and in May of 1955 he enlisted in the United States Air Force. He served with the Air force for twenty two years, retiring in 1977.
