Duane J. Perron, 77, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Tuesday, September 4, 2012 at his home.

He was born August 4, 1935 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Leo and Aimee "Mae" Perron. Duane graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1954 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Following his graduation, Duane enlisted in the U.S. Army and served for two years as a medic in Germany.
