KINGSFORD - Edith E. Brin, 74, of Breitung Township, died Sunday, March 21, 2010, at her home.

She was born on March 20, 1936, in Breitung Township, the daughter of the late Joseph G. and Martha (Smith) Langsford.

Edith was a lifelong resident of Breitung Township. As a volunteer for the Breitung Township Volunteer Fire Department, she was the first female volunteer firefighter in the state of Michigan.

She married Willard J. Brin on Oct. 5, 1957 at Immaculate Conception Church in Iron Mountain. He preceded her in death on Aug. 25, 1999

Edith was the head cook at Pine Manor (ManorCare) Nursing Home for 28 years. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church. Edith enjoyed cooking, baking, gardening, and spending time with her family.
