Edith L. Vergowven, 79, of Iron Mountain, died Mon. Feb. 20, 2012 at ManorCare Health Services. She was born on Feb. 15, 1933 in Cleveland, OH to Dorothy (Metcalf) and Robert Cauffman.

Edith was a longtime resident of Monroe, MI and attended Monroe Public Schools. She married Robert Vergowven, Sr. at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Monroe on Feb. 14, 1953. The couple moved to Iron Mountain in June of 2000.

Edith had a strong faith and was dedicated to helping others. In Monroe she was an active member of St. Paul United Methodist Church, where she helped with the women's ministries, Christ's Kids, Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and many other activities. In Iron Mountain, she belonged to the First Covenant Church and had served as the chairperson of Covenant Women and belonged to the Bible study group. Edith also served as a Red Cross Volunteer, helping with many blood drives.

She was a wonderful wife and mother. She enjoyed reading and crocheting, especially afghans and doilies.
