VULCAN ? Edmond Joseph Paquin Jr., 77, of Vulcan, and a former resident of Iron Mountain and Quinnesec, died Sunday, Aug. 17, 2003, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

He was born Nov. 12, 1925, son of the late Edmond and Dora (Sparpani) Paquin. He was a lifelong resident of the area. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy at the age of 17 and served from Dec. 14, 1942 to Nov. 11, 1945, engaging in many naval battles. He was honorably discharged with the rank of Gunner's Mate Second Class. He married Janet Turner on March 8, 1969, in Iron Mountain. Ed was co-owner and manager of Hosking Tire Company for more than 40 years until his retirement in 1990. He was an avid hunter, fisherman, and Green Bay Packer Fan. He loved his dogs and the outdoors.

He was preceded in death by an infant son, Dennis Lee Paquin in 1947; and his beloved wife of 33 years, Janet.
