



## Edward Beauchamp

January 12, 1924 - January 12, 2012

Edward L. Beauchamp, 88, of Iron Mountain, died Thursday, January 12, 2012 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. He was born April 22, 1923 in Escanaba, MI, son of the late Alex and Rose (Derwin) Beauchamp. Ed graduated from Kingsford High School in 1941. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII, in the Pacific Theater with the 25th Infantry Division. On October 9, 1948, he married his wife Lorayne in Far Hills, N.J. She preceded him in death on July 23, 2009. Ed worked as a carpenter for Ed Lafleur & Son Co. from 1960 until 1979. He then worked for Paul C. Lundy Builder Inc. from 1979 until 1985 at which time he retired. Ed enjoyed the outdoors including fishing, water skiing, and snowmobiling. Ed and Lorayne loved to square dance and they spent over 20 years wintering in Florida. He was a member of Immaculate Conception Church.

He is survived by many nieces and nephews including Cheryl (Dave) McKay of Florida. He was preceded in death by 4 brothers, Clarence, Arthur, Leo, and Adrian Beauchamp, and by 1 sister, Arlene Bishop.
