RANDVILLE - Edward Dallapiazza, 88, of Randville, passed away Friday, Nov. 13, 2009, at the Golden Living Center in Florence.

Ed was born on Dec. 30, 1920, in Norway, the son of the late John Edward and Mary Catherine (Nora) Dallapiazza. He spent his childhood in Norway and East Kingsford and graduated from Kingsford High School in 1939. He then went to work for the Civil Conservation Corp and served during World War II in the U.S. Army from 1941-1946.

In 1941, Ed married Elizabeth Catherine Feldhusen in Iron Mountain and they celebrate 61 years together. They had one son, John Edward Dallapiazza.

Ed worked for the Ford Motor Co. in Kingsford. He later owned the Sportsmen's Bar in Aurora and worked construction, joining the Labor Union in 1963. He also worked for MichCon and was a deputy sheriff for the Dickinson County Sheriff's Department. Ed and Betty moved to Randville in 1969, where he could enjoy his favorite past times of hunting, fishing, gardening, and raising various animals. He was an active member of the Sagola Sportsmen's Club and was a life member of the Disabled American Veterans (DAV).

Ed is survived by his son, John Dallapiazza (Lynn Larson) of Iron Mountain;

his sister, Irene Laylin and her son, Darrell, both of Pembine, Wis.; three grandchildren, Lorrie (Tom) Droese of Appleton, Wis., Amy (Bob) Habeck of Hinsdale, Ill., and John (Shante`) Dallapiazza Jr. of Centennial, Colo.; six great-grandchildren, Victoria and Nicole Droese, Emily and Katie Habeck, and Anthony and Lydia Dallapiazza.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Betty and his sisters, Beatrice Uecker, Elaine Flom, and Eleanor Johnson.
