Edward J. Piatti, 99, of Kingsford passed away peacefully on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers.

Ed was born August 20, 1926, in Iron Mountain, MI, son of the late Joseph and Erminia (Romagnoli) Piatti. A 1944 Iron Mountain High School graduate, Ed served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He married Margaret Draxler on September 2, 1950, at St. Mary & St. Joseph Catholic Church in Iron Mountain; she preceded him in death in 2021. Ed spent over 30 years working as a pipefitter, both at the Niagara papermill and the Mead paper mill in Escanaba. He was a dedicated volunteer at the VA Hospital in Iron Mountain for over 20 years and a longtime member of American Martyrs Church in Kingsford.
