KINGSFORD - Elaine R. Collick, 89, formerly of 706 E. Margaret St. in Iron Mountain, died Friday, March 13, 2009, at ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

Elaine was born Feb. 27, 1920, in Otter Lake, Mich., daughter of the late Malcolm and Fern (Porter) Fife. She graduated from Northern High School in Detroit in 1938.

Elaine married Fred Collick on Sept. 13, 1941, in Detroit. In the eighties, Fred and Elaine moved to Iron Mountain, where Fred was raised. He preceded her in death on April 6, 2001.

Elaine was a member of First United Methodist Church in Iron Mountain and served on the ladies guild for a number of years. She enjoyed bowling and in fact, once bowled a 200 game; reading; and helping out at the United Sportsman's Club where her husband, Fred was an active member. Fishing, hunting and camping were a big part of their lives together for many years.
