From 1942-43 she worked at the Archie Studio until moving to Camp White Oregon to be with her husband before he was shipped to Africa in January 1944 with the Army's 91st Infantry Division. Together they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 1992. Harold preceded her in death on July 15, 1993. Elaine was a member of First Presbyterian Church. She was an avid bowler and bowled at Chickies for A and W, LoDal, the Tuesday night ladies league at Kingsford Recreation Lanes, the senior citizens league on Friday afternoon and the senior league while wintering in Arizona. Elaine loved to crochet, afghan and do crafts. She was a great pasty and pizzelli maker. Her family was small but she loved them so much.
