Elaine J. Radloff, 86 of Iron Mountain, passed away peacefully on Thursday, December 6, 2012.

She was born on October 18, 1926 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Ernest and Zelma (Sovey) Lancour. She attended the Iron Mountain Schools, graduating from Iron Mountain High School.
