Eldon E. Reed, 81, of Kingsford, passed away on Sunday, October 24, 2021 at Dickinson County Healthcare System in Iron Mountain, with his family at his side.

Eldon was born November 26, 1939, in Marinette, WI, son of the late Marx and May (DeLaet) Reed. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1957 and was a lifelong resident of the area.
