NIAGARA, Wis. - Eleanor A. O'Donnell, 92, of Powers, formerly of Niagara, died Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2007, at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers.

She was born on May 14, 1915, in Vulcan, daughter of the late William and Margaret (O'Neil) MacDonald.

She married Edward O'Donnell in Norway in 1938 at St. Mary Catholic Church, and he preceded her in death in April 1984. Eleanor was a lifelong resident of the area.
