PLYMOUTH, Wis. - Elizabeth A. Righter, 88, of Plymouth, formerly of Iron Mountain, passed away Thursday, Sept. 19, 2013, at the Plymouth Care Center.

Elizabeth was born on April 6, 1925, daughter of the late Frank and Ethel (James) Ponchaud, in Crystal Falls. She attended Crystal Falls schools and graduated with the class of 1943 from Crystal Falls High School. In 1946 she married the late Bennie J. Holm.

Over the years, Elizabeth worked at the Roma Restaurant, Schaeffer's Store, The Shoe Box, and the Iron County Medical Care Facility, retiring in 1986.

On Aug. 11, 1976, Elizabeth married George Robert Righter and they made their home together at Lake Emily. After retiring, Elizabeth and George joined the snowbirds, spending their winters in Winter Haven, Fla., and summers in the U.P. Eventually they became residents of Florida and in January 2011 relocated to Iron Mountain. In September 2012, Elizabeth moved to Plymouth to live with her daughter.
