LORETTO - Emery J. Perron, 45, of Loretto, died suddenly of an apparent heart attack on Wednesday, May 24, 2006.

He was born Feb. 22, 1961, in Iron Mountain, son of Duane and Lillian (Blazier) Perron. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1979. He was a lifelong resident of the area and had lived in Loretto for the past 15 years.

Emery served in the U.S. Marines Corp. and served aboard the USS Nimitz. He was awarded the Navy Marine Corps Medal, one of the highest peace time awards, for valor over and above the call of duty. He was a former member of the Uren-Cooper-Johnson American Legion Post 50.

Emery was employed at Grede Foundries for the past 17 years and currently worked as a sand lab technician. His favorite pastimes were hunting, fishing, and spending time at camp.

He is survived by his son, Emery Perron Jr.; his fiance, Lynn Belaire of Norway; his parents, Duane and Lillian Perron; two brothers, Philip (Andrea) Perron of Iron Mountain and Brian (Jeanne) Perron of Mundelein, Ill.; one sister, Valerie Haberkorn of Spread Eagle, Wis.; his best buddy, Abbey, his

dog; many aunts; uncles; nieces, nephews, and cousin.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Leo and Aimee Perron and Norman and Kathryn Blazier; a brother, Glen; a nephew, Benjamin Perron; a brother-in-law, Jack Haberkorn; and a niece, Gail Asselin.

A celebration of his life will be held on Saturday from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. at the Randville Community Hall in Randville.
