Emery J. Steiner, 85, of Iron Mountain, died Mon. April 2, 2012 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. He was born on May 16, 1926, in Iron Mountain, the son of the late Joseph and Florence (Forrest) Steiner.

Emery graduated from Iron Mountain High School and served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He worked at the Niagara paper mill for many years.
