Emily B. Anderson, 93, of Aurora, went to be with the Lord on Mon. April 4, 2011 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. She was born on June 27, 1917, the daughter of the late Camiel and Stephanie (Van Gasse) Van Pembroke.
