



## Erick Jacobson

Erick W. Jacobson, 68 of Quinnesec, passed away on Friday, October 19, 2012 at Marquette General Hospital. He was born on August 16, 1944 in Marquette, son of Mary (Valela) and the late Robert W. Jacobson. He attended the Ironwood, Kingsford and Ishpeming Schools, and graduated from Ishpeming High School in 1962. He enlisted in the United States Army and was Honorably discharged in 1967. He worked as a butcher and car salesman, until going to work at the Oscar G. Johnson V.A. Medical Center in Iron Mountain for more than 25 years before retiring. He was a resident of Quinnesec for more than 34 years with his late wife Sheryl and their three children. Erick married Julie Skrivanie on February 23, 1999 and have been together for the past 13 wonderful years. He enjoyed baseball, hunting, trout fishing, cooking, wine making and was an avid Green Bay Packers and the Detroit Tigers fan. But more than that he lived his life for his family, spending time with his children and grandchildren was what he loved.
