Erna C. Nocerini, 88, of Niagara, formerly of Aurora, passed away Sunday, September 5, 2010, at Maryhill Manor Nursing Home in Niagara.

She was born on May 27, 1922, in Iron Mountain, the daughter of the late Jorgen and Kristine (Hansen) Jorgensen. She graduated from Kingsford High School in 1940 and went on to attend the Iron Mountain Business College. Following her schooling, she worked for Abbott Fox Lumber Co. in Iron Mountain.
