Ernest Paul "Ernie" Giuliani, 67, of 100 Maple St. Kingsford, passed away on Thursday, October 14, 2010 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

Ernie was born September 14, 1943 in Norway, MI son of the late John and Theresa (LaVoie) Giuliani. He graduated from Vulcan High School in 1962 and was a lifelong resident of this area. He married his true love, Lois Ann Hulce, on October 8, 1966 in Loretto. Ernie was employed at Lodal, Inc. in the shipping/receiving department for 40 years, retiring in 2002. He is survived by his wife, Lois Ann; a son, Paul Giuliani of Ferndale, MI; a daughter, Brenda Phare of Westland, MI; a brother, John Giuliani of Vulcan; two grandchildren, Aranda and Zakary Phare; a very special friend and

caregiver, Marie Calkins and several nieces, nephews and friends.

He was preceded in death by a son, Sgt. Scott Giuliani in May of 2009, an infant son, David Paul Giuliani and two brothers, David and Lawrence Giuliani.
