IRON MOUNTAIN - Eva Marie Eslinger, 90, of 625 East C St., Iron Mountain, died Tuesday March 31, 2009, at Hyland Nursing Home.

She was born on Dec. 24, 1918, in Iron Mountain and was the daughter of the late Gust and Anna (Quist) Nelson. She had been a resident of the East side Iron Mountain her entire life. Eva graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1936 and also attended vocational school in Green Bay. She was employed at Cochran Freight Lines for 10 years and then at Clairmont Transfer for 30 years.

She married Owen "Biff" Eslinger on Sept. 2, 1944, he preceded her in death on March 2, 1998.

Mrs. Eslinger was an active member of First Covenant Church for many years.
