KINGSFORD - Evelyn E. Frankovich, 91, of East Kingsford, entered into rest on Wednesday, March 4, 2009, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

She was born on Aug. 30, 1917, in Iron Mountain, the daughter of the late Fred W. and Julia (Gilbert) Olson.

Evelyn married Joseph S. Frankovich on Feb. 1, 1936. They resided in Kingsford and Iron Mountain, where she worked for General Controls for 10 years. The couple then moved to Jackson, Wis., where Evelyn worked for a medical supply company, Badger Laboratories, before moving back to their home in Kingsford.

She was a member of Our Saviour's Lutheran Church. She especially enjoyed her special friends in her ladies circle and Owls senior group at the church. Evelyn volunteered at the Breen Center for many years and at the blood bank. She enjoyed senior trips, playing bingo and cards with her friends.

who helped Evelyn maintain her independence in her own home until the time of her death.
