QUINNESEC - Evelyn T. Lieburn, 72, of Quinnesec, died on Tuesday, June 30, 2009, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

She was born on Nov. 17, 1936, in Lenox, Mo., daughter of the late Carl and Anne (Stuckinsnider) Parker.
