



## Francis Parsons

Francis "Frank" Parsons, 80, of Kingsford, died Thursday, November 10, 2011, at the Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community in Kingsford.

He was born August 18, 1931 in Kenosha, WI, son of the late Raymond and Gladys (Simpson) Parsons. Frank graduated from Union Grove High school in 1949. He served in the U. S. Army during the Korean War. Frank married Patricia Fisher on November 3, 1951 in Racine and they moved to Iron Mountain in 1954. Pat preceded him in death in September of 2009. Frank was employed at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Iron Mountain for 32 years before retiring in 1988. After his retirement, he worked as a funeral assistant at the Erickson-Rochon & Nash Funeral Home. He was an active and faithful member of Our Saviour's Lutheran Church and served on the church council. Frank was also very active in the Dickinson Area Ultreya. He and his wife Pat were very proud to have been parents to eight foster children over the years.
