Gail L. DeClark, 70, of Niagara, WI, passed away Saturday, October 12, 2024, at Maryhill Manor in Niagara following a lengthy battle with Multiple Sclerosis.

Gail was born on August 19, 1954, in Iron Mountain, MI, daughter of the late Andrew and Joyce (Olsen) Bolander. In 1972 she graduated from Kingsford High School, where she was a member of the National Honor Society. A lifelong resident of the area, Gail worked at the Shopko camera counter for 14 years. She was also head of the Florence County Chapter of the American Cancer Society and Golf-A-Thon for A.C.S. at the Spread Eagle Golf Course. Despite her many physical challenges, Gail still enjoyed gardening, baking, canning, and berry picking.
