George H. Cross, 81, of Kingsford passed away Friday, October 30, 2020, at the Oscar G. Johnson V.A. Medical Center in Iron Mountain.

George was born December 24, 1938 in Rockingham, NC, son of the late George and Abbie (McDonald) Cross. He enlisted in the U.S. Army and proudly served his country for 17 years and was also a Vietnam War Veteran. George married Marie T. Giuliani of Vulcan on November 18th, 1965.
