Gerald “Jerry” Carollo, 86, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Friday, April 8, 2022 at UP Healthsystem Marquette.

Jerry was born January 23, 1936 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Joseph and Mary (Lupini) Carollo. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1954 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Jerry was a veteran of the United States Navy where he served his country for four years. Following his honorable discharge from the Navy, Jerry continued to serve in the National Guard for eight years.
