Gerald Vincent Hallman, 93, of Breitung Township passed away Sunday, June 9, 2024, at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers, MI.

Gerald was born February 1, 1931, in Iron Mountain, MI, son of the late Theodore and Evelyn (Oliver) Hallman. Gerald graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1949 and was a lifelong resident of the area. He served in the Michigan National Guard for several years.
