



Gerald "Jerry" Schinderle

September 21, 1944 - May 23, 2015

Gerald A. "Jerry" Schinderle, 70, of Punta Gorda, Florida passed away on Sat. May 23, 2015 from a brief illness.

Gerald, or "Jerry," as he was known to his friends was born in Iron Mountain on September 21, 1944, son of the late Joseph and Mary (Andreoli) Schinderle. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School and received a football scholarship to Hillsdale College, where he earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree.

Jerry married his high school sweetheart, the former Mary E. Curran, and they were constant and devoted companions for 52 years until she passed in 2014. Throughout life they were each other's best friend, champion and caretaker.
