KINGSFORD - Gladys Marie Doucette, 88, of 313 Wolcott Ave. in Kingsford, passed away on Saturday, Jan. 17, 2009, at Aspirus Hospital in Wausau, Wis., after a brief bout with cancer.

She was born on Feb. 1, 1920, in Park Falls, Wis., daughter of the late Martin and Hazel Wahlstrom. Gladys has lived between Kingsford and Tipler, Wis. almost her entire life. She graduated from Kingsford High School.

She married Edward C. Doucette on June 17, 1939, and he preceded her in death in 1991.
