Glenn E. Windell, 88 of Aurora, died Thursday, March 17, 2016 at Maryhill Manor in Niagara, with family at his side. He was born on Dec. 9, 1927 in Aurora, the son of the late Einar and Ann (Pearson) Windell.

Glenn graduated from Kingsford High School in 1946. He was a dairy farmer and retired from the Florence County Highway Commission where he had worked for many years.
