



## Glenord "Glen" Jenkins

February 17, 1930 - October 15, 2010

Glenord J. "Glen" Jenkins, 80, of White Birch Village, passed away on Friday, October 15, 2010 at Maryhill Manor Nursing Home in Niagara.

He was born February 17, 1930 in Stephenson, MI, son of the late James and Helen (Bayee) Jenkins. Glen graduated from Kingsford High School in 1948 and enlisted in the U.S. Air Force, serving in Japan for two years during the Korean War. He married Adele Reis on May 10, 1958 in Milwaukee, WI. Glen was employed by Champion International in Milwaukee as a machine set-up man for over 42 years. He retired in 1995 and moved back to this area in 1997. Glen was a member of American Martyrs Catholic Church. He was an avid outdoors man and enjoyed hunting, fishing and camping. Glen was a dedicated family man and loved spending time with his wife, children and grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Adele; two daughters, Marie (Todd) Doerpinghaus of Palatine, IL and Judy Holter of Milwaukee; three sisters, Lorraine Rhodes of Milwaukee, Darlene Gurosh of California and Joyce (Harlan) Pirlot of Appleton; four grandchildren, Ryan and Matthew Doerpinghaus and Jacob and Jonah Holter; four brothers-in-law; three sisters-in-law; and several nieces and nephews.

Glen was preceded in death by a brother, Norman Jenkins and an infant

brother.
