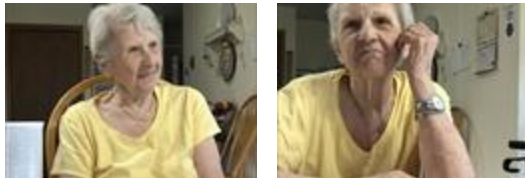
“ Some of my favorite memories about Grandma Grace are. . .
